

Q: How do I become a member?

A: MEMBERSHIP:

Membership is open to all adults (18 years and above), male and female Who hail from the 19 towns that make up former Idemili local Government of Nigeria, and also other females by virtue of marriage to indigenes of Idemili.

(i) An applicant shall fill out the union's official membership application forms.

(ii) Every person who qualifies for membership,

(a) Shall remain in good standing.

(b) Able to meet the union's financial obligations.

(c) Able to attend the general monthly meeting.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS:

(i) Enrollment Fee: There shall be an enrollment fee of \$10.00 payable on admission into the union. This fee is subject to an increase anytime the members deem it necessary.

(ii) Annual Dues: There is an annual due of \$120.00. All members are expected to pay 2 up this money in a monthly installment of \$10.00 and the whole money must be paid no later than the end of the financial year. Financial year is from January 1st to December 31st.
